RE: Tourism Golden Events Hosting Program Application for Crankworx British Columbia 2021

To the Tourism Golden Board of Directors:

Crankworx Events, Inc. is excited to return to Golden to produce Crankworx British Columbia 2021 with the support of our partners, Kicking Horse Mountain Resort, the Golden Cycling Club, and the team at Tourism Golden.

While we had originally planned to apply for a contribution of \$10,000 from the Tourism Golden Events Hosting Program to contribute to the overall costs for the events in Golden, we are hoping that we may now request \$20,000 to help us cover the additional costs of producing the Psychosis DH race on September 26th.

There are a few logistics and services that were offered at a discounted or complimentary rate for the 2020 edition of the Psychosis DH, such as the safety services provided by Golden and District Search and Rescue, which will now be a cost to the event in 2021 (please see Exhibit A). We are happy to pay for these services and are hoping that the additional contribution from the Events Hosting Program will help to ensure that we will produce a safe and memorable event for the Golden community and our Crankworx athletes.

While we anticipate that we will return to producing Crankworx Whistler in 2022, we are hoping to be able to continue working with our Golden partners to produce future editions of the Psychosis DH race.
